
Fuel Injectors - Remove And Install (23 455 0)


Remove

- 1. Remove the fuel pump fuse (fuse number 5 up to '96 MY or fuse number 33 from '96 MY onwards) from the central junction box.
- 2. Start the engine and allow it to idle until it stalls.
- 3. Crank the engine for five seconds to ensure the fuel rail pressure has been released.
- 4. Refit the fuel pump fuse.

CAUTION: Disconnect the battery negative lead.




• 5. Disconnect the vacuum pipe from the fuel pressure regulator.




When disconnecting multiplugs do not pull on the wiring; pull on the multiplug body.


• 6. Disconnect the four fuel injector multiplugs.




C 7. Disconnect the fuel supply and return pipes from the fuel rail (two unions).




C 8. Remove the oil filler cap and crankcase vent cap to aid removal of the fuel rail assembly.



• 9. Remove the fuel rail (two bolts).




C 10. Remove the fuel injectors (eight bolts).




C 11. Refit the components in reverse order.

Renew the fuel injector O-ring seals. Lubricate the fuel injector O-ring seals with clean engine oil to aid installation.
