




Disconnect the battery negative lead.

 - 2 Remove the two remaining radiator grille retaining screws.




Disconnect the fluid cooler hose from the power steering fluid reservoir.

Allow the fluid to drain into a suitable container.




C 3. Disconnect the power steering gear pipes from the clamp (one screw).


Remove the pipe clamp plate bolt and disconnect the fluid cooler pipe from the steering gebody.






